Welcome to the 2023 Marching Band Season!!!

It is hard to believe that the annual band camp experience is only a couple of weeks away. Over the summer, the instructors have been busy planning and working on the 2023 Marching Show, 'Immortalis'. Their vision, hard work and love of music combined with the talent of our children will craft together an amazing program that we will all be proud of in the fall.

#### **BAND FEES**

Band fees this year are \$300.00 for BOTH marching members AND color guard! A \$100.00 family discount is given to families with multiple siblings in the marching band. We are continuing our installment fee option to assist families in paying their band fees. Contact our Treasurers with any financial questions or concerns. (e-mail - prbbtreasurer@gmail.com)

All band fees are due by August 3rd. If mailing payments, please be sure to mail your payment to our PO Box 1624, Indian Trail, NC 28079. If any student has a credit balance at the end of their senior year (or final year in band) due to fundraising credits, the balance will be moved to the general fund. If the student has a younger sibling in the band the credit balance will be transferred to their account. Band fees pay for transportation to football games, competitions, uniforms, show shirts for all students, shorts and hoodies for freshman and new students, instruments, props, show music, drill, instructors, contest registration fees, etc.

Any unpaid band dues will be transferred over to PRHS and become an outstanding school payment. This could affect your student from getting parking passes, buying Prom tickets and more.

#### 2023-24 SHOW T-SHIRTS, SHORTS AND HOODIES

ALL band members will receive ONE show shirt. Freshman and new students only will also receive a pair of shorts and a personalized PR Band hoodie. There will be one opportunity to order extra shirts, shorts and hoodies for students and family members.

All new band students will automatically receive these. However, if you are a returning band student your old hoodies and shorts can still be used. If you would like to purchase the new ones you may do so on the band of pirates website.

#### UNIFORM/SHOE/GLOVE FITTING:

We will begin fitting for marching uniforms during band camp and will need volunteers to assist in fitting and pinning uniforms to be altered. Please contact the Uniform Chairperson to volunteer your time. All uniform contracts must be signed by both student and parent and returned by, August 1st

Band/Color Guard members can size & purchase gloves & shoes on Friday, August 5th during camp. This will be the only time to size & purchase shoes & gloves. Please be sure to send the order form and money with your student on this day.

#### **BAND CAMP**

We need volunteers to work during the days of band camp. A Band Camp Volunteer Signup Genius email will be sent out shortly with volunteer time slots. Our volunteers assist the students with water, fruit & first aid while they are outside during the morning (and evenings on the 8a-8p days.) (we would like to have a parent nurse on hand.) This is a fun and very rewarding experience where parents have bonded and made some life long friends.

#### **BAND CAMP LUNCH**

Students are required to bring a bagged lunch that does NOT REQUIRE refrigeration or heating. Please note that NO students are permitted to leave campus during band camp. No exceptions.

#### BAND CAMP DINNERS

Dinners will be available for each 8am-8pm day. You may order these online only through our website www.porterridgeband.org

Students that don't order dinners will need to bring their own. (nothing that requires refrigeration or

heating). Students are not permitted to leave campus during dinner. No exceptions.

#### **BAND CAMP ITEMS TO SHARE**

With so many band students we are in great need of some donations for Band Camp. A Sign-up Genius will be sent out via email by the Band Camp Committee. Please consider helping the students out with donating an item or two. The items are available at Walmart or on Amazon, and cost between, \$2-\$7.

At 8:00pm, prior to the band performing, we will have the first Band Booster meeting of the 2023-24 school year in the cafeteria. At that time, you will have the opportunity to learn more about our committees, drop off your completed volunteer forms, meet and talk with fellow band parents and hear about important upcoming band news.

We will follow this brief meeting with the first preview of 'Immortalis', the 2023 Band of Pirates marching show in the stadium.

#### **VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES & UCPS RULES:**



- At Porter Ridge, our last competition of the season is as the host of our own competition The Pirate Cove Classic usually the last or next to last Saturday in October held at the Porter Ridge campus
- Competitions function as a fundraiser for the host school. Our very own Pirate Cove Classic is our second largest fundraiser, behind the Citrus & Pecan sale
- Concessions and memorabilia are available at all competitions for the visiting bands and fans
- If the competition falls during a meal period (lunch or dinner), the students are able to purchase concession food
